Jun Zhao, born in China in 1995, received his first piano lessons at the age of four. He continued his musical education in Germany, where he first completed a bachelor's degree, and then a master's degree at the Robert Schumann Hochschule in Düsseldorf under Prof. Georg Friedrich Schenck. He graduated from Münster Musikhochschule with a Concert Exam diploma, the highest music diploma in Germany, under Prof. Michael Keller.

He has already given numerous concerts on various stages, including the Liederhalle Stuttgart and Berlin Cultural Arts Center in Germany, the Rathaus Hall in Stadt Voerde, the Nijmegen Music Hall in the Netherlands, the Changsha Concert Hall, the Ordos Grand Theatre, the Jinan Concert Hall, the Tianjin Conservatory of Music Concert Hall, the Bell Tower Music Hall at the Wuhan Conservatory of Music, and the Tianjin Normal University Concert Hall.

He was nominated for the prestigious 64th Busoni International Piano Competition (the first from Hunan province, China), receiving high praise. Over the years, he has been awarded several German national scholarships & DAAD scholarships, as well as various international competition awards.
